

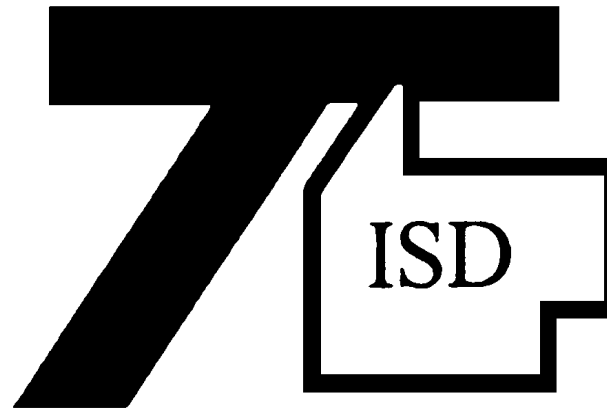
# GOAL

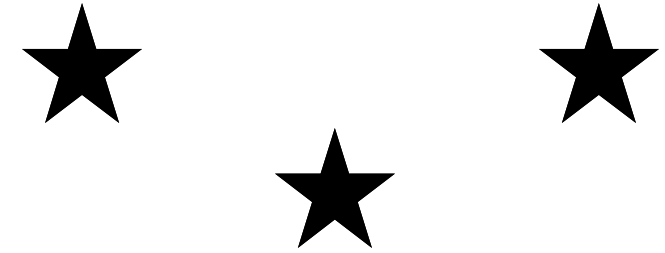

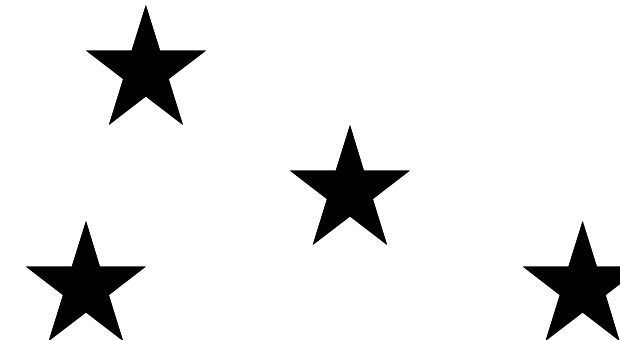

# STARS PROGRAM



The STARS program is available for Tuscola County students from the nine local district high schools and Highland Pines School.

Transition students ages 14-26, who are being assisted by Special Education, are referred by their teachers to the Transition Coordinator for participation in the program.

Students attend STARS for a semester, 2 1/2 hours per day, five days per week. Credit is granted by the local district upon successful completion of the STARS curriculum.
