As you may know, the Johnson City School District will begin the year in a Hybrid learning model for the safety and well-being of the entire school community. In the hybrid model students are separated into two groups, JC and Wildcat, to indicate the days of the week that they will attend in-person learning. This model allows us to reduce the number of students in each in-person class in accordance with the safety and social distancing guidelines.

#### **Parent Portal**
