



## Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ)

*What will I need to bring with me when I register?*

- Proof of identity (State of CT photo ID, or a current, valid government issued ID and a current utility bill, mortgage document, lease or rental agreement, bank statement, or pay stub)

*How long does registration take?*

- Up to two (2) hours

*How long do classes run?*

- Approximately 12 weeks

## Credit Diploma Program

- Interested students must take assessments and meet standards for entry into the Credit Diploma Program
- An official transcript is required. Students must meet minimum credit requirements
- A diploma is granted by the East Hartford Board of Education upon satisfactory completion of 22 credits
- A student may be eligible to receive:
  - Work experience credit
  - Community Service Credit
  - Military
- No student will be granted a diploma unless he/she has completed at least two (2) credits in East Hartford Adult Education
- No student who has left the regular school program can be granted a diploma until after his/her own class has graduated
